Dear Bethel Church Family,
As we look around our campus, we continue to thank the Lord for His abundant faithfulness. The progress on Phase Two of our building project has been a tremendous encouragement, and with completion now in sight, we are reminded that every step has been made possible by God's provision through the generosity and prayers of His people.

We also want to thank you for your continued patience throughout the construction process. The temporary inconveniences have been met with grace, and we are grateful for the unity and encouragement that have characterized this season in the life of our church.

As we near the finish line, we'd like to share an update on the project's funding. Through the generosity of our congregation and the proceeds from the sale of land to Duke Energy, much of Phase Two has been funded. However, based on the most recent projections, we are still approximately \$100,000 short of fully paying for the project from funds specifically designated for the building.

Our prayer and desire is to complete Phase Two using gifts dedicated to the building project, just as Bethel has sought to do with previous building

efforts. While the Lord has provided other resources, the Jackson estate, that could be used if necessary, preserving those funds would better position us for future ministry opportunities, including the eventual Phase Three of our campus plans and other general ministry needs.

If you have not yet had an opportunity to participate in the building project, or if the Lord enables you to give beyond your original commitment, we invite you to prayerfully consider making a gift to the Building Fund. Every gift, whether large or small, helps move us closer to completing this project debt-free and preparing our campus for generations of gospel ministry.

Thank you again for your faithful generosity throughout this project and in the ongoing ministries of our church. Your giving allows us to care for our facilities, serve members of our congregation, extend mercy to those in need, and support the work of the gospel both near and far.
