Shorter Catechism Question:

Prayer for: Growth in love and compassion toward our neighbors

Day 3

Reading: Judges 1 - 2

Questions:

- Which two brothers led Israel in their conquest of the land after the death of Joshua to fight the Canaanites?
- What instances of incomplete obedience does the passage cite in Israel?

• What were the bad consequences that followed these disobediences? Whom did the LORD raise up to lead Israel?

<u>Prayer for</u>: Personal renewal of body & spirit

Day 4

Reading: Judges 3

Questions:

- Who did the LORD leave in Canaan to test Israel, whether they would obey God?
- What was the result of Israel inter-marrying with these nations?
- When Israel repeatedly sinned, & God judged them, what 2 judges did the LORD raise up?

<u>Prayer for</u>: To be faithful managers of our time, talents, and treasure

Day 5

Reading: Judges 4

Questions:

- What happened after Ehud died?
- What two judges did God raise up to oppose Sisera?
- Who actually brought deliverance to Israel from the hand Sisera?

<u>Prayer for</u>: Physical health & strength for ourselves, family & friends

Day 6

Reading: Judges 5

Questions:

- What did Deborah and Barak do to celebrate God's deliverance of Israel?
- What acts of obedience and worship are given in v. 2 of both the leaders & people?
- How does their song differentiate between the fate of God's enemies, & His friends?

<u>Prayer for</u>: Spiritual revival of the community and nation

Day 7

Reading: Judges 6

Questions:

- After 40 years of rest, what happened again? Who was God's judge for Israel's sin?
- What specifically caused Israel to cry out to God for help?
- When God greeted Gideon, what were his questions for the LORD?

Prayer for: Effectiveness of Bethel's ministries
