

Weekly Discipleship Plan (Week of Jan 18 - 24, 2026)

**Catechism Question: (3/5)**

Children's Catechism (2 - 5 y.o.) -

Q. 26. What did God threaten in the covenant of works?

**A. To punish Adam with death if he disobeyed.**

Q. 27. Did Adam keep the covenant of works?

**A. No; he sinned against God.**

Shorter Catechism ( 6+ y.o.):

Q.37. What benefits do believers receive from Christ when they die?

**A. When believers die, their souls are made perfectly holy and immediately pass into glory. Their bodies, which are still united to Christ, rest in the grave until the resurrection.**

Scripture Memory: **1Pet. 1:3 ¶ Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ!**

**According to his great mercy, he has caused us to be born again** to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,

**1Pet. 1:4** to an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you,

**1Pet. 1:5** who by God's power are being guarded through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.

**DAILY DEVOTIONS**

**Day 1 (Jan 18 )**

Reading: Judges 16 -17

Questions:

- What does the passage tell us about how Samson felt about Delilah?
- How did the Philistines take advantage of / exploit this, that they were able to capture Samson?
- What does Judges 17:6 mean? ?

Prayer for: For friends, relatives, neighbors who don't have saving faith in Jesus

**Day 2 - Monday**

Reading: Judges 18

Questions:

- What problem did the tribe of Dan have?
- What does it mean they "scouted out the land"?
- What part do the household gods and images play in Judges 18?

Prayer for: For the Lord to renew your mind with His truth

**Day 3 - Tuesday**

Reading: Judges 19

Questions:

- Why do you think the passage in Judges 19: 1 says for the third time “There was no king in Israel”? (17:6 / 18:1 / 19:1)
- In 19: 15-16 the passage tells us the old man took in our traveler. Why did he have to do that?
- 19:22 describes the men of the city Gibeah as “worthless fellows.” What does that mean? What difference might a king in Israel have made?

Prayer for: The Great Commission to be fulfilled

**Day 4 - Wednesday**

Reading: Judges 20

Questions:

- In the beginning of chapter 20, why did all the people of Israel gather at Mizpah?
- How did all Israel decide to respond to the murder the “worthless men” committed?
- What do you think about Israel's decision to go “inquire of the Lord” (20:18 / 20:23 / 20:27 / 21:25) about whether they should go to battle against Gibeah?

Prayer for: God's help and guidance in sharing the Gospel with others

**Day 5 - Thursday**

Reading: Judges 21

Questions:

- What do you think Judges 21:2-3 says about us, when we are in great distress?
- What was the point of the burnt offerings and sacrifices in 21:4?
- Why do you think 21: 25 is the last verse in the book of Judges?

Prayer for: The people serving in local state and national government

**Day 6 - Friday**

Reading: Ruth 1-2

Questions:

- Who was Ruth? Why does this matter to the author?
- Why does Ruth stay with Naomi? (1:16)
- How does Boaz explain the kindness he shows Ruth? (2:11-12)

Prayer for: God's protection and blessing on 1<sup>st</sup> Responders (police, fire, EMS, etc)

**Day 7 - Saturday**

Reading: Ruth 3

Questions:

- What kindness does Naomi seek for Ruth? (3:1)
- What word does Ruth use to describe Boaz ? (3:9)
- What kindness did Boaz show to Naomi?

Prayer for: Effectiveness in evangelism & discipleship
