Catechism Question: (1/4)

Children's Catechism (2 - 5 y.o.) -

Q. 28. What is Sin?

A. **Sin is any want of conformity unto, or transgression of the law of God.**

Q. 29. What is meant by want of conformity?

A. **Not being or doing what God requires.**

Shorter Catechism (6+ y.o.).:

Q. 38. What benefits do believers receive from Christ at the resurrection?

A. **At the resurrection, believers will be raised up in glory, will be openly acknowledged and acquitted in the day of judgment, and will be made perfectly blessed in the full enjoyment of God to all eternity.**

DAILY DEVOTIONS

Day 1 (Feb 8)

Reading: I Sam 19

Questions:

- Was it required of Jonathan, or wrong of him to tell David of Saul's secret plans?
- How did Jonathan help his friend David? Was Michal right or wrong in helping David?
- What does the passage tell us of why Saul tried to kill David?

Prayer for: For the Lord to renew your mind with His truth

Day 2 – Monday

Reading: I Sam 20 – 21

Questions:

- What is David feeling as a result of Saul trying to kill him?
- Describe the conversation between David and Jonathan.
- What do you think of David deceiving Achish the king of Gath, in David protecting himself?

Prayer for: The Great Commission to be fulfilled

Day 3 – Tuesday

Reading: I Sam 22

Questions:

- What commandment did David keep in I Sam 22:3?
- Describe the way Saul spoke to his servants / Abimelech. What is Saul's mental state?
- Describe the character and actions of Doeg the Edomite.

Prayer for: The Great Commission to be fulfilled

Day 4 - Wednesday

Reading: I Sam 23 - 24

Questions:

- Describe the circumstanced and manner of David's "conversations" with God. How do we "talk" with God today?
- What do you make of Saul's statement in I Sam 23:21?
- What do you think of David's treatment of Saul, and David's regrets as to cutting Saul's robe?

Prayer for: God's help and guidance in sharing the Gospel with others

Day 5 - Thursday

Reading: I Sam 25

Questions:

- What kind of person was Nabal?
- What kind of a person was Abigail, Nabal's wife?
- How did David describe Abigail, and her actions?

Prayer for: The people serving in local state and national government

Day 6 - Friday

Reading: I Sam 26

Questions:

- Why does David keep sparing Saul's life, when Saul keeps trying to kill David?
- Why was David able to sneak into Saul's camp and take his spear and water bottle?
- What do you think about Saul's confession and vow in I Sam 26:21?

Prayer for: God's protection and blessing on 1st Responders (police, fire, EMS, etc)

Day 7 – Saturday

Reading: I Sam 27 – 28

Questions:

- What do you think about David's reason for going to the Philistines land, and how he acted living there?
- What happened in I Sam 28, when Saul inquired of the Lord? How did Saul respond?
- What do you think of Saul calling up Samuel from the dead, and the whole incident of Saul going to a medium / witch, as to the existence of evil in the world?
