Catechism Question: (2/4)

Children's Catechism (2 - 5 y.o.) -

Q. 28. What is Sin?

A. **Sin is any want of conformity unto, or transgression of the law of God.**

Q. 29. What is meant by want of conformity?

A. **Not being or doing what God requires.**

Shorter Catechism (6+ y.o.).:

Q. 38. What benefits do believers receive from Christ at the resurrection?

A. **At the resurrection, believers will be raised up in glory, will be openly acknowledged and acquitted in the day of judgment, and will be made perfectly blessed in the full enjoyment of God to all eternity.**

DAILY DEVOTIONS

Day 1 – Sunday (Feb 15)

Reading: I Sam 29

Questions:

- How did Achish describe David to the Philistines?
- Why did the Philistines not trust David?
- Why was David trying to get the Philistines to trust him? Was this wrong for David to do?

Prayer for: Growth in love and compassion toward our neighbors

Day 2 – Monday

Reading: I Sam 30 – 31

Questions:

- What happened while David was away from home in Ziklag? How did the people respond? How did David respond?
- After defeating the Amalekites and recovering all their families and goods, what statute did David make?
- How did Saul die? Why do you think Saul died in such a horrible way?

Prayer for: Personal renewal of body & spirit

Day 3 - Tuesday

Reading: II Sam 1

Questions:

- What news did the unidentified man bring David? How did David react to Saul's death?
- How did David react to the man claiming to have killed Saul? Why? Why do you think he claimed to have killed Saul?
- From II Sam 1: 17 – 27, describe David's eulogy of Saul and Jonathan.

Prayer for: To be faithful managers of our time, talents, and treasure

Day 4 - Wednesday

Reading: II Sam 2-3

Questions:

- What significant thing happened to David? Who anointed another king over Israel?
- Describe the situation between the families (houses) of David and Saul. What happened to David's family?
- What had God promised David?

Prayer for: Physical health & strength for ourselves, family & friends

Day 5 - Thursday

Reading: II Sam 4

Questions:

- Given how Saul treated David, is it surprising David mourned Ishbosheth being murdered? Why?
- How did David react to those who murdered Ishbosheth? Why?

Prayer for: Spiritual revival of the community and nation

Day 6 - Friday

Reading: II Sam 5 – 6

Questions:

- Describe the situation when all Israel made David king.
- Why did David become “greater and greater”? What did David know from this fact?
- What did David do with the ark? What terrible thing happened along the way?

Prayer for: Effectiveness of Bethel's ministries

Day 7 - Saturday

Reading: II Sam 7

Questions:

- What 2 things did God do for David?
- How did God react to David wanting to build a “house” (temple) for God?
- Describe the promise / covenant God made with David.

Prayer for: The church-planting movement in Mexico
