**DAILY DEVOTIONS**

**Day 1 (Sun Mar29, 2026)**

Reading: I Kings 22

Questions:

- What was Ahab's reasoning for going into battle at Ramoth-gilead (22:3) ?
- Compare the prophecies of all the other prophets vs. that of Micaiah the son of Imlah.
- What explanation did Micaiah give as to the heavenly counsel about Ahab's plan to go into battle? What does this teach is about who we listen to?

Prayer for: For the Lord to renew your mind with His truth

**Day 2 - Monday**

Reading: II Kings 1-2

Questions:

- What happened to King Ahaziah that he inquired of Baal-zebub, the false god of Ekron?
- What was the reason given for the king's death in 1:16?
- What was unique about Elijah's entrance to heaven and Elisha's response to it?

Prayer for: The Great Commission to be fulfilled

**Day 3 - Tuesday**

Reading: II Kings 3

Questions:

- What cause the alliance between the kings of Israel and Judah to go into battle against Moab? What other nation joined them?

- What was Jehoshaphat's advice when the armies of Israel and Judah ran out of water?
  - Summarize Elisha's prophecy. Did it come true?
- Prayer for: God's help and guidance in sharing the Gospel with others

#### **Day 4 - Wednesday, April 1**

Reading: II Kings 4

Questions:

- What miracle did God do for the wife of one of God's prophets? Why was a miracle needed?
- What kindness did the Shunamite woman show to Elisha? How did he repay her kindness?
- How do Elisha's miracles show God's fulfillment of II Kings 2:9?

Prayer for: The people serving in local state and national government

#### **Day 5 - Thursday**

Reading: II Kings 5

Questions:

- Discuss the attitude of the young girl in captivity displayed in 5:3.
- Discuss Elisha's instruction for Naaman's healing and his response? Are we like this at all?
- What did Gehazi do that displeased God? What was his punishment?

Prayer for: God's protection and blessing on 1st Responders (police, fire, EMS, etc)

#### **Day 6 - Friday**

Reading: II Kings 6

Questions:

- What does the miracle of the iron axe head that floated teach us?
- Discuss 6: 8 – 12
- Discuss 6: 16-18
- Discuss the great kindness Elisha showed the Syrians in 6: 22-23.

Prayer for: Effectiveness in evangelism & discipleship

#### **Day 7 - Saturday**

Reading: II Kings 7

Questions:

- How serious was the famine in Israel?
- What miracle did God do to scare off the Syrian army around the city?
- Compare and discuss the beginning and end of chapter 7.

Prayer for: Growth in love and compassion toward our neighbors
