

Weekly Discipleship Plan (Week of May 3 – 9, 2026)

Catechism Question: (1/4)

Children's Catechism

Q. 33. What befell our first parents when they had sinned?

A. Instead of being holy and happy, they became sinful and miserable.

Q. 34. Did Adam act for himself alone in the covenant of works?

A. No; he represented all his posterity.

Shorter Catechism

Q42. What is the essence of the ten commandments?

A: The essence of the ten commandments is to love the Lord our God with all our heart, with all our soul, with all our strength, and with all our mind, and to love everyone else as we love ourselves.

Q43. What introduces the ten commandments?

A: These words introduce the ten commandments: "I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery."

Scripture Memory: **1John 5:13** ¶ I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, that you may know that you have eternal life. **5:14** And this is the confidence that we have toward him, that if we ask anything according to his will he hears us. **5:15** And if we know that he hears us in whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests that we have asked of him.

DAILY DEVOTIONS

Day 1 (Sunday May 3)

Reading: I Chron 21

Questions:

- What foolish idea did David have? Where did it come from?
- When David repented, what 3 choices did God give David for his punishment?
- Discuss David's prayer in 21:17.

Prayer for: Matt 6 – That God supply our daily physical and spiritual needs

Day 2 - Monday

Reading: I Chron 22 – 23

Questions:

- What various preparations did David make for the Temple to be built?
- What duties does 23:28 – 32 give the Levites?
- How do they differ from the duties of Aaron and his sons? (23:13?)

Prayer for: Eph 3: 10 – for God's wisdom be shown to all, through His church

Day 3 - Tuesday

Reading: I Chron 24 - 25

Questions:

- What lesson(s) do we take away from the detailed “chronicling” of Aaron’s sons ?
- What does the phrase the musicians “prophesied” with their instruments mean?

Prayer for: Col 1:9 - To be filled with a knowledge of God’s will, and obey Him in spiritual wisdom and understanding.

Day 4 - Wednesday

Reading: I Chron 26 - 27

Questions:

- Gatekeepers were those who kept order in the Temple. How is that important today?
- How frequently did the 12 divisions perform their military service in David’s army?
- What other leadership did David set up in Israel?

Prayer for: Prov 3: 5-6 – To trust in God with all our heart, and not rely on our understanding, alone.

Day 5 - Thursday

Reading: I Chron 28

Questions:

- Summarize David’s “charge” to Israel. (28: 1-8)
- Summarize David’s charge to Solomon. (28: 9 – 10)
- What did David give Solomon in preparation for building the Temple?

Prayer for: John 4:24 That God help us worship Him in spirit and truth,

Day 6 - Friday

Reading: I Chron 29

Questions:

- After itemizing his preparations for the Temple. What question did David ask Israel ? (29:5)
- How did the people respond? (29: 6-9)
- Summarize David’s prayer (29: 10 – 21)
- What 2 events complete the book of I Chronicles?

Prayer for: To gain a deeper understanding of what it means to be “in Christ.”

Day 7 - Saturday

Reading: II Chron 1-2

Questions:

- What was Solomon’s first recorded after establishing himself as king?
- That night, what did God say to Solomon? How did Solomon respond?
- What did Solomon then do in II Chron II?

Prayer for: Matt 6 – For God not to send us testing – that He deliver us from evil and the Evil One
