

Weekly Discipleship Plan (Week of May 24 – 30, 2026)

Catechism Question: (4/4)

Children's Catechism

Q. 33. What befell our first parents when they had sinned?

A. Instead of being holy and happy, they became sinful and miserable.

Q. 34. Did Adam act for himself alone in the covenant of works?

A. No; he represented all his posterity.

Shorter Catechism

Q42. What is the essence of the ten commandments?

A: The essence of the ten commandments is to love the Lord our God with all our heart, with all our soul, with all our strength, and with all our mind, and to love everyone else as we love ourselves.

Q43. What introduces the ten commandments?

A: These words introduce the ten commandments: "I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery."

Scripture Memory: **1John 5:13** ¶ I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, that you may know that you have eternal life. **5:14** And this is the confidence that we have toward him, that if we ask anything according to his will he hears us. **5:15** And if we know that he hears us in whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests that we have asked of him.

DAILY DEVOTIONS

Day 1 (Sunday May 24)

Reading: II Chron 26 -27

Questions:

- How old was Uzziah when he was made king? Did he initially do good or evil in God's eyes? What are some examples of the good things he did?
- Why did he become prideful? What was God's punishment of his pride?
- How did Jotham compare to Uzziah? Describe the people of Israel at this time.

Prayer for: Matt 6 – That God's name (and person) not be used carelessly, but be worshipped and glorified.

Day 2 - Monday

Reading: II Chron 28

Questions:

- What "abominations" did Ahaz practice? How did God respond to Ahaz's sin?
- Summarize Oded's message to Israel, regarding their treatment of Judah.
- Describe the state of affairs in Israel describes in 28: 16 - 27

Prayer for: Matt 9: 38 – that God send laborers into His harvest

Day 3 - Tuesday

Reading: II Chron 29

Questions:

- Describe Hezekiah's repairs to the Temple.
- What instructions did Hezekiah give to the priests and Levites?
- How did Hezekiah restore Temple worship in 29:20 – 30?

Prayer for: I Thess 4:13 – that we would be sanctified, and keep ourselves from immorality

Day 4 - Wednesday

Reading: II Chron 30

Questions:

- What prevented the celebration of Passover & what did Hezekiah do to fix the problem?
- Discuss 30: 8 and how people can respond to the call to worship God.
- Describe what all happened in keeping the Passover feast.

Prayer for: I Pet 4:2 – that we no longer love to fulfil the desires of the flesh, but rather to do God's will

Day 5 - Thursday

Reading: II Chron 31-32

Questions:

- What does it mean that "all Israel....broke in pieces.... And cut down... and broke down all the high places" in Judah?
- What does it mean that Hezekiah's "every work...seeking his God, he did with all his heart"?
- Compare / contrast 31: 31, where we are told Hezekiah "prospered" and the invasion of Judah by the king of Assyria (32:1)

Prayer for: Matt 6: 33 To seek God's kingdom above all else, and wait on Him for everything else.

Day 6 - Friday

Reading: II Chron 33

Questions:

- Describe Manasseh's sin and God's judgment of him and his people.
- What happened after 33:12 and Manasseh's distress and "entreating" the favor of God?
- How does 33: 21-23 compare and contrast Amon with his father Manasseh?

Prayer for: For the effectiveness of Bethel's ministries

Day 7 - Saturday

Reading: II Chron 34

Questions:

- What lesson(s) are there for us in the kings of Judah doing good vs. doing evil before God?
- How did Josiah "walk in the ways of David his father"? What great find was made by Hilkiah?
- What was the basis of Huldah's prophecies of "disaster" vs. "peace" ?

Prayer for: Isa 26:3 – God keep our minds focused on Him, and give us His peace.
